

# SCORE Curriculum Change Workshops 2010

As part of its commitment to improving access to high quality STEM activity in schools, SCORE is working with the British Interactive Group to support STEM providers in understanding and implementing changes to the English National Curriculum for science and maths. Three one-day workshops will run during February 2010 to this end.

Each workshop is designed to inform those offering STEM activities to schools about changes and to help generate new delivery ideas.

Aimed principally at STEM providers whose role is to develop school programmes, each workshop will provide:

- An overview of changes to the English National Curriculum for science and maths at primary/secondary levels including key developments anticipated over the next few years
- An outline of the motivations for change
- Information about how the role of STEM providers is complementing these changes, and how schools will use providers' services in the future
- Interactive sessions led by STEM providers showcasing activities which have embraced curriculum change for Mathematics, Scientific Process (primary session) and How Science Works (secondary sessions)
